- **Visual Design:** We have improved contrast sensitivity on all file buttons and follow a logical heading hierarchy (H1, H2, etc.) to support screen readers.
- **Testing:** This site was last self-tested on 1st February 2026 using the [WAVE Web Accessibility Evaluation Tool](#). The main site scored 8.9/10, and the Cemetery sub-site scored 9.8/10.
