Written notice of an objection must first be given to the auditor and a copy sent to the smaller authority. The auditor can be contacted at the address below during the inspection period which commences on the 13<sup>th</sup> June and ends on the 25<sup>th</sup> July.

The smaller authority's Annual Governance and Accountability return is subject to review by the appointed auditor under the provisions of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014, the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015 and the NAO's Code of Audit Practice.
